The Panopto App works on all tablets and phones running Android 5.0 or above. This guide walks you through the steps required to download the app and start recording with your personal devices.

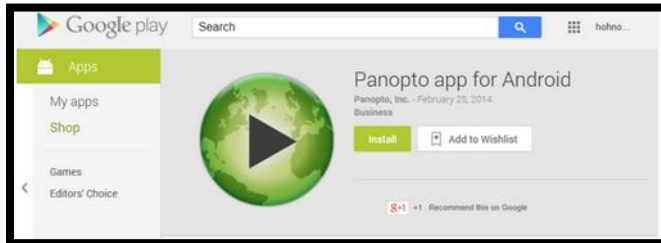

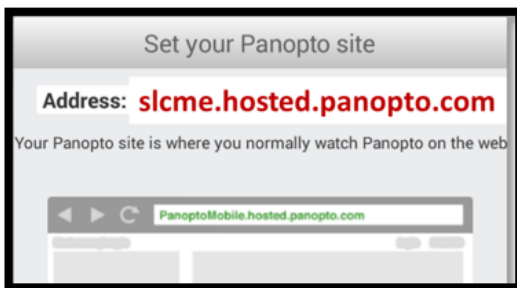
Downloading the Panopto App for Android

1. Go to the **Google Play App Store**.
2. Search for Panopto and click **install**



Using the App for the first time

1. Click on the **Panopto App** icon to open it.
2. Click **sign in** (top right of the screen)
3. When prompted for the address, enter **slcme.hosted.panopto.com** and click **OK**
4. A new sign in window will open. Use your **Blackboard credentials** as your **username** and **password**, and click **Sign in**.

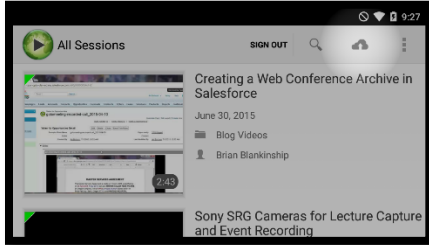


Create Recordings

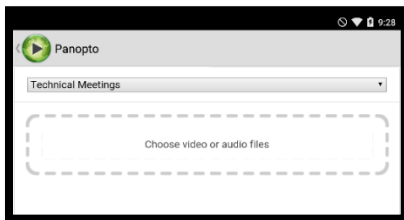
The Panopto app allows you to preview and create recordings using any of the Remote Recorders you have access to.

Upload existing videos

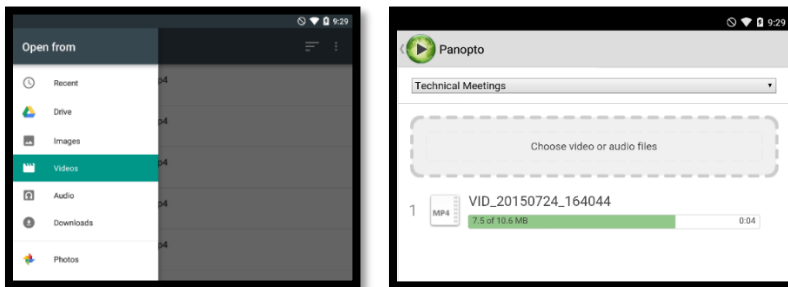
1. Tap the upload icon in the toolbar (for phone users, it may be in the “...” menu).



2. Select a folder on your Panopto site and tap **Choose video or audio files**.



3. Once you select the video or audio file, the update process will begin. A progress bar will display during the update process which will identify the amount of the update remaining to complete.



Note: Videos can take a substantial amount of time (10+ minutes) to upload to Panopto from your Android device. The amount of time is dependent on the size of the video and the internet connection being used. **Use WIFI** connections rather than mobile data wherever possible. Uploading video uses a substantial amount of data.
